GLEN OAK PROTOCOLS

Arriva

Glen Oak provides complimentary valet parking along with a bag drop as you enter the Club. Over-flow parking for the Clubhouse is located across Hill Avenue from the main parking lot. Mark Rudins, Men's Locker Room Manager or Geri Hoffman, Women's Locker Room Manager will assist you upon arrival.

Smoking

Smoking is prohibited inside the Clubhouse and within 15-feet of any Club facility. Use of recreational drugs, including cannabis, on any portion of Club property is strictly prohibited.

Mobile Devices

Ring tones should be silenced when on Club premises. Please limit the use of cell phones while on the golf course. Please be courteous when using your cell phone within the Oak Room and locker room areas. Calls are only allowed in the locker room.

Golf Course Attire

Attire on the golf course should conform to a style accepted as appropriate for the golf course. This includes: golf shirts, sweaters, pullovers, jackets, slacks & golf shorts of an appropriate length. Shirts are to be tucked in and hats are to be worn with bills facing forward. Inappropriate dress includes: denim, cut-off shorts, cargo shorts, athletic wear, short shorts/skirts, and t-shirts.

Clubhouse Attire

Country Club Casual is acceptable in the Mixed Grill, Couples' Lounge and outdoors. For men appropriate dress is slacks, golf shirt, golf shorts, and other-collared shirt. Men must remove hat/golf caps when in the Clubhouse/Oak Room. Appropriate dress for women is slacks, golf shorts, dress, skirt (appropriate length), blouse, sweater, and sport/golf shirt. Children should follow similar attire as adults. Tasteful fitted denim may be worn (no holes, fraying or fading). Inappropriate attire includes cut-offs, short shorts, mini-skirts, halter tops, athletic wear, swimwear, & t-shirts.

Pace of Play

Four hours or less is our goal and allows full enjoyment by all Members and Guests. Groups failing to keep pace and falling behind by one hole may have to skip a hole to catch up. Play ready golf.

Taking Care of the Course

Replace divots properly. Put them back the same way they came out. Rake traps thoroughly and properly. Always enter and leave the trap from the low side and avoid the high side of the trap. Keep motorized carts away from tees & greens. Observe the marked restricted areas and cart paths. Repair your ball marks on the greens.

Lightning Rule

When the siren sounds the golf course is closed and you must leave the golf course immediately and come to the Clubhouse. If the Clubhouse is too far to reach, then go to the nearest on-course shelter.
